

MORGAN HILL PONY BASEBALL - 2007 PALOMINO DIVISION

OUTLINE OF PLAY

Division Philosophy:

The Palomino Division is a highly competitive Division, where all players are engaged in either playing High School or Collegiate Baseball. This league is designed to showcase a player's ability, giving them more playing time, and access to professional and college scouts.

Division Structure:

The Palomino team is a select team that will be hand picked by the manager of the team, in accordance with the rules of the league and national rules and approved by the President of MHPB.

Field Preparation:

It is the responsibility of the players with the supervision of the manager and coaches to prepare the field before and after any games or practices.

Managers and Coaches:

Managers and Coaches will be selected by the Division Rep and approved by the MHPB Board. All Managers and Coaches should have coached in MHPB, or, have some other type of baseball coaching experience. Managers and Coaches who are volunteering in MHPB will be asked to fill out an application and meet with the DR to discuss their baseball background and coaching philosophy as it pertains to youth sports. The Managers and Coaches best suited for providing the best possible instruction, guidance, training, and positive and effective sports attitude will be selected.

Practice Scheduling:

The Manager will provide each player with a practice schedule at the earliest possible time.

Seasonal Play:

Seasonal Play will be governed by the rules of baseball unless modified by the rules of Pony Baseball, unless modified by the rules of the interlocking league. As this is baseball at the very highest level, minimum play time is not considered.

Manager's Meetings:

As there is only one team, Managers meetings will not be required, however the manager should keep the DR and the Player Agent abreast of any situations or issues that may arise.

Tournament Play:

The team will be entered in the National Pony Tournament, if they qualify. Other non-sanctioned tournaments may be entered before or after the conclusion of the National Tournament, but the players must carry the costs of any such entry.
